<u>DRAMATIC ORDER KNIGHTS OF KHORASSAN</u>, popularly known as the "dokeys", is the playground of the Order and is dedicated to helping give life and hope to their fellow man. (Auxiliary "Nomads of Avrudaka")

<u>JUNIOR ORDER</u>, for boys from 10 to 17 years of age, provides an opportunity for training as future Pythian Knights.
